ElectroGas Malta Ltd is a private entity, responsible for the operation of the Delimara LNG Terminal and Delimara 4 Power plant, generating electricity for Malta from LNG, in a safe and reliable manner.

ElectroGas Malta and its Contractors are committed to mitigate all environmental impacts resulting from the operation and maintenance of plant used for generation of electricity by combustion of natural gas, storage and bunkering of LNG, by implementing an environmental management system, and to ensure that all operations are compliant with applicable environmental legislation. ElectroGas Malta commits that it will make appropriate resources available to achieve this.

To achieve our policy aims we will:

- Aim to identify best environmental options and ensure that environmental impact, including provisions of oil spill response are considered when planning or carrying out work.
- To promote energy efficiency in our operations, in relation to the emissions generated.
- Communicate as a responsible operator on our environmental performance to stakeholders and the public.
- Actively require and promote environmental compliance and awareness through effective training and communication programs amongst staff and contractors.
- Maintain strict vigilance over all ElectroGas operations to ensure that these conform to the required standards, with a view towards evaluating scope for improvement.
